

Chapter 6

The peace process, asks the IRA to give up its weapons and stop bombing. The UK government simultaneously bombs innocent civilians by the Thousands, and Hundreds can be killed in a day, despite its own population asking it to end. (February 2003)
Calling for war, with one voice, and peace with another.....

The Orange Order manifests itself when it tries to disguise itself with vigour. The most revealing insight into this phenomena, is the book about the documentary “The Committee” by Sean McPhilemy⁴⁴⁷. The documentary although shown on television by Channel 4 was eventually banned and the book although published and released, was “withdrawn” and buried by legal hurricanes and dirty tricks.

A journalist named within the book, Martin O'Hagan, has recently been killed, presumably by means of a “blind spot” (according to Lord Williams of Mostyn QC, High Court Judge in 1991 presiding over the McPhilemy hearings) which alluded to the fact that the Police (Royal Ulster Constabulary) were promoting terrorism, not preventing it. McPhilemy's book and documentary outlines the British States policy on assassination of “Fenians” joining the dots of a picture linking state, civil service and paramilitary/army it highlights “elimination” policy permeating every quarter. This means an invisible yet legislated (by “The Committee”) legalised shoot to kill policy. A prominent member of the committee was/is (William) David Trimble M.P⁴⁴⁸. (and Orangeman), who has denied it, in legal actions winning his case. A parallel with Reverend Ian Paisley is his secret army, he trained and commands, this is also denied.

The European court of Human rights ruling on the Pat Finucane case has said that the British state investigation into the shooting of the solicitor by “Loyalist forces” was flawed, and since the state is also responsible, state sanctioned murder of Republicans and Roman Catholics (non- combatants) it cannot investigate itself⁴⁴⁹. The latter findings of state collusion with the security forces and paramilitaries is a finding of Police Commissioner (Sir John Stephens commissioner of the metropolitan police), it is therefore, now a fact, and can be traced to the Apartheid beginnings of Dutch theology many centuries before. here both the London parliament through its police commissioner and the European courts have now admitted this, which is tantamount to saying the peace process, since its inception was a declaration

of war, a fact that many in Ulster and world wide suspectedand so the nonsense continues

Mr Trimble, who stood on a platform of independent Ulster (separated from England and E.I.R.E.) and went on to win the Nobel Peace prize jointly with John Hulme* of the Social Democratic and Labour Party (* Hulme is considered a “dove” as opposed to a “hawk” by the Orange Order, “hawks” or “hardliners” were prime elimination material).

The furore the book and documentary caused was and is incredible, matched possibly only by the public relations war against John Stalker, Deputy Chief Constable of Greater Manchester Police⁴⁵⁰

He was sent to investigate claims concerning the shooting of six men by the Royal Ulster Constabulary, in trying to gain access to information not even the Director of Public Prosecutions could help him, fuelling speculation that indeed there was a state “shoot to kill” policy. He relates, how, after his “suspension” (following a long campaign by the R.U.C, on 29th June 1985), a Sunday newspaper wrote how combined influences in the R.U.C. and Orange Order and Greater Manchester Police “were at the heart of my troubles”, he eventually left the force. Recent under cover BBC programmes reveal tha tracism is rife in new recruits, and as such is institutionilised. My own experiences, learnt from relatives, and their colleauges within the police force, state whilst they personally try and ignore and remove themselves from this position it is made very difficult to do so

In the collusion/shoot to kill “investigations” any brief trip to a bookshop, Waterstones for example, will show that these revelations are true..... when coming from a non-republican source, and could be seen easily , cheaply and quite readily.

When these other and more horrorfying revelations came to light, there is hardly a flicker of concern.

For example, “The Nemesis File”¹⁴⁵¹ by Paul Bruce, a former S.A.S. man (who dares wins!). It is laced with murders and killings, containing intricate plots with the R.U.C. and Loyalist Paramilitaries and with glossy photographs of mass burial graves of kidnapped “Fenians” neatly filled with bulldozers and planted over, even detailed ordinance survey “reconn” maps supplied. Bruce describes how during an execution op “He had sometimes wondered where the hell the orders were coming from? He knew damned well they would not come from the S.A.S.” how odd!

Although he does point to the headquarters in Lisburn as “the army, and those bastards in Lisburn who remained aloof in their headquarters while

ordering us to carry out despicable, cowardly acts, killing 40 people” (Lisburn, early headquarters intelligence security company, intelligence corps, 12 intelligence and also 14 company, also old established Orange Lodge).

Bruce was told on recruitment by “intelligence” after being briefed by Brigadier Frank Kitson, son of Admiral Kitson, “You will be part of an abduction and assassination operation”¹, this was a part of Kitson's outlook and new directive outlined in his book “low intensity operations”⁴⁵², a blueprint for the future “smothered war” in Northern Ireland (Mirroring Colonel Proutys assessment of wars since “ww2” i.e a no win war) They do however generate large amounts of profits for arms manufacturers.the latest tarde arms fair in England is part of a world wide arms trade which Britains share is £36 Billion⁴⁵³, selling both to Saude Arabia and Isreal and indeed anyone who wishes to buy) His directive was ordered (or mouthed!) by Prime Minister Edward Heath in July 1971, when the “non active” role of the British Army would be no longer “defensive” but an “active one”. This is just one book which adds weight to the claims of McPhilemy and Stalker.

The army had originally entered Ireland to keep the “peace” between the two “sides” after Prime Minister Heath had rejected the Republicans suggestions on a United Nations “Peace” keeping “force”. Later S.A.S. (who dares wins!) assassin Paul Bruce was incredulous on discovering that the “Top Brass” at intelligence had “ordered us to stir up trouble on the streets of Belfast” “to change tactics” he is horrified to learn “Now we were being ordered to go out on the streets and kill totally innocent people, just young men we happened to come across walking down the streets in Catholic areas”. (This sounds like a shoot to kill type thing).

Therefore in peace, the army is defunct,it needs to keep the war going, whilst maintaining it is there to keep the peace.this requires a merry go round of spin and public relations, and control of the media.It is also indictative of the split personality of the “Dutchs” governments ability to appear as what it is not, i.e. 1)in anyway a part of these Islands 2) “British” 3) Patriotic .If peace arrives and spending is cut,this “peace” cannot be allowed to break out without Westminster’s legislation. It follows the low intensity blueprint of the Orange Order “to take up arms against the Crown, to protect the Crown” this is a code, which seeks to protect the City and Bank of England against its own populous Protestant or Catholic as Protestants” innocent can also be assassinated even by “Loyalist” paramilitaries. Many of them cite in defence of their actions that the 1798

rebellion in Ireland led by the United Irishman (but a revolution in which many protestants also supported ?), there was a doctrine of “Murder without Sin”,⁴⁵⁴ supported by the Roman Catholic church, of course if this was wrong then, it still is.?, whichever Christian denomination blesses it.

Further revelations of strange and contradictory actions are detailed by James Rennie in “The Operators”,⁴⁵⁵ he discloses operations detailed by Bruce as joint actions between 14 Company (“The Operators”) and the S.A.S. (Who dares Wins!) and Special Branch (R.U.C.) and MI5, showing it as a government initiative. “The Operators” act like Mission Impossible personnel in plain clothes, spotting, identifying and marking a “target”* (all with Government permission).the target is then eliminated, by either S.A.S or Loyalist Paramilitaries... however anyone can be hired if they have the mercenary experience and attitude. Unfortunately they sometimes got it wrong...!

Nicholas Davies in “Ten-Thirty Three” describes the “Secret Killing Machine” in Northern Ireland, and the conspiracy between British Military Intelligence and the gunmen of the U.D.A. (Ulster Defence Association).⁴⁵⁶ Chris Ryder in “The RUC“ shows the connections between the Orange State and working class Protestants and the RUC's role in co-ordinating a link between the working class and “their wealthier betters”,⁴⁵⁷ whilst “Phoenix” by Jack Holland highlights the tensions between the intelligence forces and the need to share intelligence. The book shows the lack of trust between the R.U.C. and British Intelligence or rather between the Orange Order and British Intelligence⁴⁵⁸.
Its hard to appreciate, especially when MI5 have a office in their Embassy in Dublin.

The Orange Order may have to take up arms against the Crown (as the crown is now Dutch –German in origin) to protect the Crown. Jack Phoenix who was killed in the Chinook helicopter crash on 26th June 1994,he was considered a “Tiegue (Catholic) lover” by others in the security forces. All of these books go further than McPhilemy or John Stalker and verify their findings, marking the absurd nature of undercover journalism which strenuously seeks to undercover the truth , seemingly unable to walk into the local highstreet bookshop

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I once met an international evangelist, mainly resident in Ulster, who after travelling the globe witnessing to people in remote areas, said he would not

travel over the border to the “South” as it was off limits. Not because he was afraid, or doubtful of results but because he had hate in his heart. This unfortunately is a two way street.

Chris Ryder, in his book on the R.U.C. relates how the “Scoti” or Ulster Protestants who settled in Scotland were in Ulster first as the “Cruithne” and here we have the R.U.C. as Cruithne colluding to kill their distant cousins “The Mileadh” whilst the Orange Order connections are discussed by Steve Bruce in “The Red Hand Protestant Paramilitaries in Northern Ireland” who though recognising their “Cruithne Pictish” roots did not want to know this part of history, preferring history to begin with William of Orange and the Act of Union, again outlining the Ulster-Scottish connections of the Orange Order, who preferred a kilt and bagpipes, resonating in step to a “Military” tune.⁴⁵⁹ rather than the free piping which members of the Strathclyde police pipe band tell me they love and would rather play.

Bruce goes further to analyse “Paisleyism” and the free Presbyterian agenda, which in part ensures we do not allow a “Pope” to become the Anti-Christ world leader, who will head the European Economic Community⁴⁶⁰, presumably or preferably to allow an Orange Anti-Christ type to rule instead, and Reverend Paisley is a member of parliament for the European parliament....the horror, the irony.

Reverend Paisley's private army and Orange anti-Catholic rhetoric is not based on just concerns for the Gospel although many testify it used to do so, to-date it seems he has never accused anyone outside Roman Catholics circles of being the Anti-Christ.

Trying to justify Apartheid Bruce excuses the “doctrine” as follows “it separates us, from them (us ...i.e. Orange Presbyterians) almost ‘double separation’ in that they must distance themselves not only from error, but also from organisations which, although ORTHODOX (my underlining) maintain cordial relationships with unsound denominations”. So separation needs to be maintained. However, if the “Separated” do not wish to be segregated can they ask their brother Christians to relent but Bruce continues “He (God) thus knows whether we are damned or saved in advance of our being born”

“On consequence is to suppose that some of us have been chosen for salvation, are part of the elect and others are not”.

Bruce goes on to say that of course only God knows who is part of that elect ? yet despite this he states

“there has always been a strong tendency for popular Calvinism to slide into racism. Calvinists have tended to suppose that their children have a higher than even chance of being part of that elect”

He continues “other” races or religions are unlikely to be a part of that elect.

“It should be easy to see how a group of Calvinist Presbyterians can turn inwards, suppose that the hostile outsiders are not part of the elect, and then concentrate on preserving their own religion rather than taking the evangelical position of trying to convert as many of the HEATHEN as possible” (underlining mine)

In security policies, it naturally follows that the converting of the heathen takes second place to assassinating them instead, making up Gods mind for him eliminating him from the decision making process, hoping that he will “bless it afterwards”

Of course if God is not “in it” then the next step is to form your own secret society, give it an outer Christian image, organise yourselves like parasites on a host onto the state and run an assassination machine with a disguised shoot to kill policy.(Amen)

“According to Smyth, (Reverend Martin, Grand Master Orange Order), the Reverend Ian Paisley has made an original contribution to Ulster Protestation; by fusing the Politics of Orangeism with the religion of fundamentalism”⁴⁶¹

Indeed journalism in Northern Ireland cites the resemblance's to South Africa¹ and its Apartheid system, where Protestants, whom of course are not Catholic, are black and citations from the Book of Genesis likening their colour to the “Mark of Cain” or unlike Adam and Eve, Africans cannot blush (presuming tentatively that our first parents were white and Anglo – Saxon.) these ideas fuse Orangeism and fundamentalism in that context. Jesus of course was brown, and in a hot month, black., and he had a propensity to drive money changers out of the temple. Modern theological/philosophical debate amongst the German /British Anglo – Saxon hierophants would almost have us believe that Jesus was himself a part of the master race, and was walking around Roman – Palastine, dressed in tweeds saying things like “indupetedly” and “what what”.

A quieter matter concerning “The Scots” both Protestant and Catholic is “Britain’s Secret War, Tartan Terrorism and the Anglo-American State” in which similar techniques to those in Northern Ireland are employed in Scotland. A long history of bombings, assassinations and terrorism does not

seem to make the news as much as Northern Ireland, perhaps it is harder to define just who the terrorists are. It is harder to classify people as terrorists twenty-two miles over the water from Northern Ireland, if they are not following the “blueprint” for “low intensity operations” Catholic, Protestant conflict. Perhaps the delicate nature of “Scotland’s” role for Nato’s” aircraft carriers for the U.S.A. means editing techniques and new prioritising can exclude Scotland’s longest trial, longest jail sentence and the most intensive scrutiny of her internal political situation by the C.I.A. and Britain’s Secret police” we have seen up until recently. Who knows of the mysterious death of Scottish nationalist Willie McRae?⁴⁶² .

We can glean a picture of how this can be achieved in “Twilight Warriors inside the Worlds Special Forces”, to see the close co-operation on secret “black” operations between U.S.A. Navy Seals and the Royal Navy as “Anti-Terrorist” units and between the Green Berets and the S.A.S. monitored closely by the C.I.A.⁴⁶³ , whilst managing to keep a close eye on Wall Street and its bankers for British interests.

The secret services of “WW1” were organised by Sir William Wiseman, whilst America kept out of the war it was able to flood the European continent with its own produce taking advantage of the trade wars between England and Germany, and yet despite this Wiseman was able to operate and recruit both in America and England.

He turned an organisation called M.I.1C into MI6.⁴⁶⁴ His successor William Stephenson helped shape O.S.S. during World War II, once again America delayed from entering “ww2” ,instead flooding the world markets with its produce before deciding to save us from the horror of living under occupation of Nazi Germany, this is being typed in 2002 in Anglo –Saxon, under a government which views war as the saviour of the western economy, with a monarchy related to the Germanic kings of the 1st 2nd and 3rd Reich’s. O.S.S in turn became the C.I.A. under General Donavon. Donavon was no more than an adventurer loaded with cash, seeking out deals to further Anglo-American interests, whilst his colleagues helped smuggle Nazis into Britain and America. William Wiseman helped President Woodrow Wilson’s aide, Colonel House, “prepare” the biggest Bank centralisation/privatisation in history now known as the “Federal Reserve Bank”, covertly passed through congress in 1913 in time to print interest bearing notes to loan to all sides in “ww1” it is still a privately owned company, removing the role from treasury of the united States and therefore the people to print , control and issue money. This therefore is not controlled by the people or by a democracy⁴⁶⁵ He also helped Woodrow Wilson to

(although reluctantly) declare war, a feat managed (reluctantly) by Roosevelt in World War II

It is little understood that it was Colonel house who ran the Whitehouse with president Wilson rehearsing his lines, wheeled out for the press and coerced to sign whatever he was told.⁴⁶⁶

It appears “Britain” have long been masters at spying, and the budget jumped to £70,000.00 a year in 1660, under the Lord Protector, Cromwell and his spymaster John Thurloe who was “to make the English Secret Service the most efficient in Europe in the space of a very few years”.⁴⁶⁷ The Lord Protector, Cromwell “did not allow his strong religious prejudices to interfere with his foreign policy”⁴⁶⁸ of course with “Dutch” finance he could afford it with a bankroll from the Bank of Amsterdam. England must become like its host country Holland. Thurloe became Secretary of State, Home Secretary, Chief of Police, Head of Secret Service, Foreign Secretary, War Secretary and Councillor of State!⁴⁶⁹ and no doubt Chief Treasurer.

Thurloe divorced his Puritan prejudice and allowed Antonio Fernandez Carvajal amongst many others to settle from Spain with Cromwell's permission and they became his agents.⁴⁷⁰ The Bank of England was formed in 1694 and William of Orange, pre-occupied with his Dutch war ensured correspondence between himself and his number one in England (William Blathwayte) who helped control Williams agents such as Melville, Lord Grey, Lord Mordaunt, the Earl of Stamford, Rutland, Manchester, Chalmondley etc., he returned the exiled (from Holland) Earl of Macclesfield. Blathwayte ran England as Minister and Secretary of State for War, while William was “away” and all of this was paid for by the British taxpayer.

The long history of Patriotism in delusion extends up to today in the U.S.A., where genealogists will try to trace “ones” roots to William of Orange, to gain prestige for those seeking membership in an extended royal family. Not everyone is successful but no doubt their Puritan ancestor whoever they were may have known someone who glimpsed William of Orange as he sailed in and out of England.

The extended family needs security, but it is annoying and embarrassing when the C.I.A. prove to be acting in an unchristian manner. Paisleyism has been accused of importing his brand of Presbyterianism from America⁴⁷¹ whilst the Bank of England became the model for Wall Street.

Imperialism travels and the CIA has recently announced it has re-initiated its Shoot to Kill policy against suspected terrorists (writing in December 2001), without trial, mirroring “The Committee”.

Mark Urban in “Big Boys Rules” cites how the legal system in Northern Ireland and the UK was “tailored” to suit the war and the “shoot to kill” policy.⁴⁷² The paramilitaries, the RUC, the Government and the Security Services work in legislated co-operation as displayed by Sean McPhilemy, the only difference is the system and its ex-operatives can more easily tell this story through editing techniques, filtering their way through legal proceedings.

With the murder of Northern Ireland Roman Catholic solicitor Patrick Finucane in 1989, an investigation was carried out, but this original investigation concluded that although there were serious problems with the way in which his security, and subsequent police inquiry was conducted, there was no collusion or “ordered” assassination of Mr Finucane. On June 19th of this year 2002 a newspaper in England carried the following headlines “RUC encouraged us to kill Finucane claims loyalist terrorist”⁴⁷³

This followed the B.B..C.1 Panorama investigation special “A license to kill” shown over two nights on 19/6/2002 and 23/6/2002.its conclusion was that these findings re-opened and investigated by the Stephens inquiry now for the third time went straight to the heart of the state and Whitehall. Sir John Stephens commissioner of the metropolitan police says of the 13 year investigation “it is the most extensive criminal investigation in history”. Detective Sergeant Nicholas Benwell an officer in the investigation says of Colonel Gordon Kerr “he had no concept of the rule of law”.

this was the British Army officer who “ran” the agent i.e. Brian Nelson. Nelson and members of the U.D.A or U.V.F. sometimes assassinated the wrong man, or chose not just members of the I.R.A. but Roman Catholics indiscriminately echoing Paul Bruce’s exploits in his previously cited book Nemesis.

Stirring up trouble was the key to keeping the security forces in Northern Ireland, and lessening the likelihood of peace or rather a United Ireland breaking out Taking up arms against the crown to protect the crown in the reversal of law, logic and the Judeo –Christian tradition. The programme concludes with the admission that the state has prosecuted this covert war , not as peacekeepers but as aggressors. As this is continuing it can only be

received as a declaration that the war is back on as if the past 30 years had not happened.

The continuing investigation into the Bloody Sunday shootings has now taken years costing Millions of pounds to discoverifthere was a shoot to kill policy by the state, this is a farce. The Stephens inquiry rolls on as a comedy in the face of all the people who have died in Ulster, the obvious disregard for the truth is highlighted by the nonculant way even the B.B.C. reveal the obvious whilst flawed and corrupt Legal procedure precludes any hope of Justice.

Finally in the “license to kill” broadcast Sir John Stephens and Seargent Benwell hint that M15 knew all along and in fact ran the whole murder policy as ordered by the state.

It is a different matter, if one of the possible targets decides to speak freely, McPhilemys book and John Stalkers also point to the Orange Order and its clients the banks.... hence the uproar, whereas the ex-army books leave out direct implications of Orange involvement. It is acceptable to lament over the horrors of war, in a testimonial ex-squaddie Wilfred Owen reminiscence, but do not suggest that the war is co-ordinated like an American football game, with banks and royalty and establishment figures calling the play. Today the state sanctioned assassinations continue under the direction of the FRU (Force Research Unit) and even though the limited findings of the Stephens report will be handed to the new policing board of Northern Ireland, they have no powers to investigate, M15, the Army, or incidents involving collusion with RUC/PSNI before 1999. The European court of Human rights judgement, and the UN findings, will also be handed over, even though Pat Finucane, originally took a case to the European Court of Human Rights, ironically his own state sanctioned murder finally proving his case. Since the instruments of these state sanctioned deaths are still in place then it is a declaration of war against not just paramilitaries Protestant or Catholic, but also against ordinary citizens.

Hundreds of years ago a Roman Catholic doctrine of “Murder without sin” was decreed, thus the two Christian peoples can pray and kill without conscience

The most recent report released in December 2003, the Cory report, (separate from the Stephens report) has been blocked by the security services, as it is likely to add weight to the whole collusion infrastructure,

leading from the highest levels of the British government to the shootings on the streets. Another solicitor was also killed... John Ware from the BBCs Panorama reported the following

“The judge the two governments appointed was Mr Justice Peter Cory, a man whose mild, courteous manner belies the steely spine that earned him a place in Canada's supreme court. Judge Cory has done what Blair must have prayed he would never do. Having read many volumes of very sensitive intelligence, unpublished police reports, including the one into collusion by Metropolitan police commissioner Sir John Stevens, and some papers to which even Sir John did not get access, Cory has recommended a public inquiry into no fewer than five out of the six cases. Four are in Northern Ireland and include the murder of another solicitor, Rosemary Nelson, against whom RUC officers are said to have made death threats When Judge

Cory presented his reports to both governments in October; he remarked that if either party dishonoured its commitment he would behave like his grandson when he does not get his way. "I don't think I would kick and scream and I don't think I would turn blue, but I would make a lot of noise," he said. We wait to see if the judge was only joking, for his terms of reference also commit both governments to publish his lengthy reports. The Irish have no problem with that, but the British do.

Last month, Judge Cory returned from Canada to consider requests for amend- ments. On the British side, this has turned into a gruelling marathon following the intervention of the attorney general, Lord Goldsmith. Publication has slipped twice and no firm date is being offered. The Northern Ireland secretary, Paul Murphy, says only that there are issues of "national security" and the "safety of individuals" which "need to be considered". Cory says he took these into account and wrote his report in such a way that he did not expect to have to make significant amendments. Despite the many millions of pounds spent by police forces investigating collusion in Northern Ireland over the past 14 years, only the most general conclusions - damning though they have been - have ever been published.

An authoritative official account of the gritty details of who was assassinated - and with what murky state assistance - remains hidden from the families of the victims and the public. Judge Cory was invited out of retirement into the kitchen. What passes for open government in Britain still seems incapable of withstanding the heat.”⁴⁷⁴

Further to this Her Majesty has received the following; (writes Henry MacDonald of the Observer)

“A British Army agent has been threatened with imprisonment for writing to the Queen about security force collusion with terrorists in Northern Ireland. English businessman Sam Rosenfeld spied on republicans for the Army's secretive Force Research Unit between 1990 and 1993. The 41-year-old builder worked his way into the company of IRA and republican dissidents in the Fermanagh and Tyrone areas during the early 1990s.

But he has since turned on his FRU handlers and taken them to the High Court in London, claiming that he was abandoned by Army intelligence officers. He also alleges he has devastating information about collusion between the FRU, loyalists and agents inside the IRA, who were allowed to murder in order to protect their cover.

The Ministry of Defence has now threatened Rosenfeld with two court injunctions to stop him going public about his work for FRU in the Irish border region.

He received his latest injunction order last Thursday, when MoD officials left court papers at his door. But Rosenfeld claims the most bizarre threat so far has been in the form of a threat to jail him for writing to the Queen about his case.

'I decided to write to the Queen because she is the Head of State, the upholder of our constitution. I wanted to tell that her armed forces in Northern Ireland were allowing murders to take place, letting their agents kill with impunity. That was 1 June 2002. Ten days after my letter, I had an invitation from the MoD to visit them. The threats to have me jailed are because of my letters to the Queen exposing collusion,' he said yesterday. He has subpoenaed Sir John Stevens, the Metropolitan Police Commissioner, and Freddie Scappaticci, the West Belfast man who denies he is the agent known as Stakeknife, to the High Court in London on 17 December. Rosenfeld claims that both men have valuable information which will prove his case that agents such as himself are under life-long risk from terrorist groups.

Solicitors acting for Scappaticci said that their client had never met Rosenfeld and would not be prepared to act as a witness in his case against the MoD.

Rosenfeld also claims that he has caught MoD officials committing perjury when they originally petitioned a judge on 27 November 2002 - and at subsequent hearings. 'I have found out from unreacted (blacked out) documents that there was nothing there that would compromise national

security, yet the MoD mislead the judge - statements were altered to appear differently from what they actually were.'

Rosenfeld worked for Colonel George Victor Williams, a top FRU intelligence officer who died in the 1994 Mull of Kintyre Chinook helicopter crash, in which 26 senior security personnel were killed".⁴⁷⁵

The truth is this type of warfare is worse for those who engage in its horror, and the current elections, have caused many to see that voting can work, whilst the 120,000 (a tenth of the population of Ulster) who were excluded from voting cannot see it as any different from the gerrymandering which began the civil rights movement of the early 1970s.

This in effect means the peace process, and especially the Good Friday agreement with its Christain association in its name is defunct.

Some years ago I sailed from Doolin in County Clare to Inishear, off the West Coast of Ireland, to hopefully, meet Liam O'Flaherty the writer. I was told he died the previous year on Inishmor the largest of the Aran Islands. He took part in the 1922 risings in Dublin raising the Red Flag on the Rotunda, before it was removed to be replaced by the Green. In his "Shame the Devil"⁴⁷⁶ autobiography, he wrote;

"Now however, capitalist finance has completed its enslavement of Mankind, turning five-sixths of the earth into an enslavement camp" "It is no longer possible for a hungry slave to stow himself away on a ship bound for the Argentine and eat a cow from among the countless herds that roam the pampas" "They are all in pawn to some damned financier in Wall Street, or the City of London, to fellows who would rather slaughter them and leave their bodies to the vultures than allow a hungry man to fill his belly with their flesh".

Mr O'Flaherty suffered eventually from shell shock and he reports on slipping in and out of madness into delirium, an ailment also experienced by shell shock victim Spike Milligan, both men seemed to have an underlying sadness, even through their humour. 1922 saw the death of Mr Michael Collins. General Collins, or the Minister for Finance, trained first as a post

office clerk in London (having left Cork) and then as Administrator for the “Guaranty Trust Company of New York’s London branch
His dismay at finding the O’Connor Don (the descendent of the last Irish High King) negotiating on the landlords side in the land reforms of home rule, led him to place finance as a key to the war against England. The Redmondites had already outlined partition on Ulster long before Griffiths and Collins became signatures to the treaty, which established an Irish Free State in 1922.

At the General election of 1918, Collins had raised £400,000.00 through loans, to form co-operative banks⁴⁷⁷. They offered loans with low, long-term fixed rates of interest, enabling the Irish to turn rents into mortgages. I remember my grandmother, paying £50.00 (yearly) and this was always kept on the high mantle (as in many houses), some of the last payments were received up to six years ago in Sligo. It was paid to the Bank of England via the Dial (the government) in Dublin. Does this make Ireland a freehold!?

Collins said of it “seen clearly that the success of the loan is one of our first steps to economic freedom – it is the first token of release from the strangle grip which English money – or rather our own money in English hands – holds us in”⁴⁷⁸ the Money was loaned by the Guaranty Trust Company. After Collins was assassinated a border committee was set up and “Dev” (Eamonn Develera) who had the chance to follow Collins plan “to coerce Ulster into the Republic (the four counties as Ulster was then) did not appoint himself a member, his appointed member instead turned the four counties into six. The “Orange Card” a phrase coined by Randolph Churchill, Winston's father was played¹, the Land Banks (co-operatives) were phased out, but the financial deal to buy out the land had been established.

Before his death, Collins was establishing new branches of the Co- Operative banks and they were being added all over Ireland extending northwards⁴⁷⁹. Unlike Cathal Brugha, Harry Boland, Sean Hales and Liam Lynch, General Collins never had an inquest, or an autopsy. He was taken to a British military hospital (Shanakiel) when others were much nearer (the Moray, South and North Infirmary).

Afterwards his commanding officer, with him in the car journey Major General Emmett Dalton published shortly afterwards in the Cork Examiner, that a inquiry or autopsy was not necessary. Therefore if Dalton could

suppress an autopsy he could have given permission for it Dalton went on to work in the Irish Senate and later as an actor in films in England, where he also reputedly worked for MI5 (although this is denied).⁴⁸⁰

Michael Collins modelled the civil service of the new Dail (Irish parliament) on the British example, and the new “free state” uniforms were simply Kaki British uniforms dyed Green in factories in Manchester⁴⁸¹ the British army did not withdraw from Ireland and many regiments and columns joined the Free state troops. many of the secret services and even the infamous G-MEN, many of their colleagues assassinated by Collins became members of the civil service and free state army.

Even members of Mi6 joined the new government⁴⁸² To this day two British regiments still hold travelling warrants from the Grand Lodge of Ireland, in Dublin to enter Ireland whenever they wish

“It seems extraordinary that the 4th / 7th Royal Dragoon Guards and the Worcestershire and Sherwood Foresters allow their soldiers to join lodges controlled by a foreign authority, especially one based in Dublin”⁴⁸³ MI5 still retain a “branch” within the British Embassy in Dublin, and symbolic head of English Grand lodge Prince Michael of Kent still visits the Mother lodge of Ireland in Dublin, with his wife and presumably pops into Grafton street for a pint of the “porter” careful not to give himself away, perhaps he cycles there on Collins old bike.

Martin Short further explains that eleven lodges in Germany, have as their members almost exclusively British Army of the Rhine. These lodges come under the authority of the United Grand lodge of Germany. One can almost hear the “yavole” Herr Sax-Coburg as Prince Michael Windsor sails down the Danube for a German lodge meeting.

The only change in Ireland was that there existed the possibility of a separate financial system, separate from the Bank of England.

This has caused many to call Michael Collins a traitor to the “Republic” and this was platformed by Develera and the anti-treaty forces of the Irish Republican Brotherhood

(I.R.B. became the I.R.A, and the I.R.B in turn having their origins in the Whiteboy defenders who battled the protestant peep o day boys...see chapter 5),, who also saw partition as an act of treason. yet Collins said he would not continue the war and go to it again over the form of words. this meant that it does not matter what you call your Island, as long as it has economic independence.

Collins saw the new land banks as the first step to destroy the grip English finance had them in for a thousand years.

The world wide international revolution was prepared to back any new Banking system as the old order was to be swept away, hence he sought and received the loans as did Develera

It was this new banking system that the British feared, and Collins was not pursued as intensely as when he became Minister for Finance.

The old order economically had been swept away in Russia. Even after his death and into the 1940s the Republican Develera was Taoischoch presiding over a central bank, which for all intents and purposes traded through the English system.

The Irish central bank was opened in 1943, and although Develera executed an economic war against the British and vice versa, the Irish Punt was still only as independent as the Scottish or Northern Irish banknote, in short still Sterling

Ireland itself, was as it was prior to 1922 .it was the speed of introduction and the control of the new banks which concerned the all powerful “Round Table” of the British Commonwealth the most.

Following the 1916 risings, and the Russian revolution in 1917, the British government were concerned on keeping the Jews out of Ireland. A government white paper of the time entitled “Russia No 1”⁴⁸⁴ described the ethnic makeup of the Bolsheviks as almost totally Jewish a fact it feared as there was still a British imposed Jewish curfew in existence specifically for Jews at this time, in England and Ireland.

MI6 blamed the riots in London, Belfast, Glasgow (A hotbed of Zionism as was Manchester) and South Wales on the Jewish led Bolshevik communists.⁴⁸⁵ Colonel Lane attributes these forces with the capability of funding and leading the rebellion (1916) in Ireland, giving the main reason that the Irish had not the means to carry out such a operation. This last and pertinent fact derived from the practicable extermination of the Irish by starvation and deportation and emigration for over a hundred years, obviously framing the Colonels opinion. The main perception was that to let the “Jew” into a country meant prosperity and wellbieng or at least a revolution would follow. or to put in differently they could not be suppressed or as easily put down as the famine weary Irish nation.

The war becoming one of internal takeover in intelligence circles. Field Marshall Sir Henry Wilson fearing that the Empire would be lost around the world if the Bolshevik revolution, spread across Europe into specifically Egypt and Ireland⁴⁸⁶. Collins had him assassinated in 1922 , on the doorstep of his home in London.

As already mentioned the partition of Ireland was determined many years before Collins and Griffiths signed their own death warrants, in the treaty of 1922. the international situation in tandem with world events was being overseen in Ireland by the Round Table group set up by Cecil Rhodes and Albert Milner.⁴⁸⁷

This group was prepared to dismantle the Empire, in favour of a commonwealth of nations, and it was mooted as early as 1898 that Ireland (all 32 counties) become ruled by themselves alone as long as they retained their members of parliament at Westminster. this did not find favour with the protestants of Ulster.

The Round Table also included as a member J.P.Morgan, owner of the Guaranty trust company where Collins had been employed, before the 1916 rising.

This firm had originated in England as George Peabody and company, before it relocated in America. Queen Victoria, described Mr Peabody as her favourite “American”⁴⁸⁸, his statue is located outside of the Bank of England.

Other members of the round table included Arthur Balfour, who declared Israel would become a state in November 1917. The declaration as it was known was written from the British government (Balfour was British Foreign secretary) to Lord Rothschild, promising only at that stage that a few Jewish settlers would be allowed... as would be economically acceptable to Palestinians....it has also become known as the Zionist declaration.⁴⁸⁹

It was this first tentative step to a New Jerusalem, in which some would say of Ireland that it was a “catspaw”⁴⁹⁰ in a wider international great game, the British empire needed an internal change to allow a Commonwealth to become sub- servient to a new foreign policy.

Funds and backing for a complete Republic increasing as British diplomacy and determination decreased towards Zionist aspirations. The Oil in the middle east would need a friend to acquire it, and the share of new Oil was a chip to be sold to the highest bidder.

Colonel house was also a member of the Round Table and was directly instrumental in hosting the Paris peace conference in 1919, in which Develera was refused entry.

The list of members reads like a who's who of the last 100 years and has been very influential in world politics ever since.

It was Milner who was instrumental in bringing about the Royal Institute of international Affairs, with Colonel House at the Paris peace

conference.(Versailles) in which the forerunner of the U.N. was discussed the “League of Nations”.

The Round Table later was instigator of the Council of Foreign Relations, the United Nations , Trilateral Commission , Bilderbergers and so on.this Anglo –American special relationship was fostered around the Round Table, and in effect was the thinktank of the British Foreign office, albeit one with a new and different outlook, and not staffed by the “British”.

This is why when Chief Develera left for Versailles in 1919, Collins was aware that they would not recognise his demands for a Republic. the most powerful Irishman in Ireland was Horace Plunkett, at least as far as the ”Irish Question” was concerned

In his capacity as “Chair man of Irish Convention for settlement of the Irish Question”⁴⁹¹ it was Plunkett who was given access to the ear of President Incognito Colonel House.

Friends with Arthur Balfour whom House also admired Plunkett received his position as Chairman of the Irish question in 1917.his role was to smooth Anglo – American relations which had soured after the suppression of the 1916 rising, many in the American senate urging reprisals against the murder of the prisoners, shot without trial and the brutal aftermath of the rising on the general population of Ireland

In the war against Germany the “allies” could not afford to be quarrelling over such issues and a solution to the Irish question would need to be quickly arrived at. Plunkett was instructed to send his secret reports to Colonel House at the White House to keep him informed of all developments. These reports on a need to know basis were edited and passed to President (elected) Wilson, but only so the tragic mannequin did not embarrass the establishment by saying the wrong thing.

At this time Great Britain’s empire was larger in geography and population , but House regarded Americas position as more favourable. He succeeded in arranging that Britain would not build a navy against the U.S., although it would construct war against any European country if necessary, whilst America was free to build against whoever it chose. it was recognised that America would soon outbuild Britain in any case

By such an agreement was a war between Britain and England averted in 1919⁴⁹² (30/7/1919)

Once this had been established the Irish Question was on its way to a conclusion .Ireland had published what the British called Propaganda against it , for the American audience and they had countered this by sending Sir William Wiseman to the ear of Colonel House. The secret reports in six

instalments prepared by Plunkett were also sent to Sir William Wiseman, Plunkett obeying Colonel House's instructions to do so. Wiseman in turn passed them on to the King!

Thus the intelligence network in Ireland on one level was leading measures fully to plan.

J.P. Morgan and the Guaranty trust company in America supplied Collins and Develera with the money to purchase "Ireland" back from the "Absentee landlords", and the Revolution in Ireland was monitored by all, the Irish, the U.S and the British.

Lord Northcliffe the paper magnate also sending reports to House, giving the British version of events. Finely balanced with war between Britain and America in the wind Eamonn Develera, had no hope of admittance to the Peace conference in Paris. With no American diplomacy lending aid to the Irish question in the new "peace" between the U.S. and Britain, Ireland was forced to end hostilities exchanging the few remaining bullets for a settlement..Americas growing strength ensuring Britain did not re-invade Ireland under complete dominion.

A settlement that the worlds most powerful institutions had already decided upon.

Therefore Collins who had already perceived this recognised that however limited, a new beginning with Economic independence, would lead to total independence. If Ireland had achieved full Republic status at this juncture and yet retained the imperial captivity to the Bank of England, it was just as unsatisfactory as a Dominion status under the same financial management. He knew the powerful forces behind the governments of Europe and America, was the Round Table, as Collins was a member of the Supreme Council of the Irish Republican Brotherhood..

The Co-operative banks, like the civil service could either be run by the Irish or the British, but would it be extended to the counties of Northern Ireland, where it would come into collusion with the three independent Ulster banks. Of course the land banks free to run their business meant people could choose to bank wherever they desired, the Ulster banks had a closer affiliation to the bank of England than the Dublin banks,even though all three were controlled or policed by the Orange order, even though degrees of philosophy separated them, and it had a particularly good exchange, with the Scottish banks, the bank of Scotland being the sister bank of the bank of England.

Once the land had been re-distributed and sold at very reasonable (leniently affordable), they could have become fully fledged banks of deposit, credit and commercial.

The industrialisation of Ulster , had caused Belfast to increase in population 707 % from that in 1841⁴⁹³.before the famine

Ulster's population was 50 % Roman Catholic and 50 % Protestant. After the famine the protestant population increased to 64% of the total⁴⁹⁴.The population of the border Ulster towns and countryside was therefore sparse and Catholics were the majority, lending to the view that the new independent Ulster of four counties would become economically unviable in Collins eyes

This was Collins plan, he did not realise that if he was killed and the unresolved border question that the treaty had established could increase the four counties to six

The border commission was to become a stage 2 treaty "Irish question" which is how they circumvented the difficulty in the first place.

The co-operatives were seen as Bolshevik and revolutionary, too inclined to help the working class. Ulster also bordered by the Zionist hotbed of "Red - Clydeside" and the Bolshevik hotbed of Glasgow encircling working class Protestant and Catholic populations⁴⁹⁵, was in some difficulty and Belfast had already shown signs of working class unity disturbing to the upper classes.

This aspect to Northern Ireland meant that the minister for finance was the most hunted man in Dublin. "Micael"⁴⁹⁶ as he was known in Jewish circles, had a uncanny ability to keep ahead of "Saul", but passwords and the nod were not always in Gaelic within the IRB.

Collins was a ladies man and dined often with Lady Lavery and her husband, it was Lady Lavery whose face was the subject on the Irish 5 Punt note when it was first issued.

Five days before he was shot on 22/8/1922 Collins dined with the Laveries, Horace Plunkett⁴⁹⁷ and Piaras Beasali (who later wrote a history of Collins) and Joe O'Rielly. During the meal a sniper formerly from the Connaught rangers, was discovered in a tree, planning to shoot Collins, he was taken down the field and shot dead.

Collins connection to the Plunketts and therefore British intelligence, was not a trait of treaty supporters, as Plunketts son was executed for his part in the 1916 uprising, whilst two other sons were serving large prison sentences ...this is not a motivation for helping William Wiseman and MI5 , but it was a different allegiance to the Round Table which really mattered The old order was to be swept away a philosophy replacing old boundaries , and bonding new orders.

With Collins amazing ability to see ahead and his ability to organise, and a complete awareness of how the plan in Ireland was to go down, he had acquired an in-depth appreciation of the world of Economics Working for international finance houses as well as employment in the Plunketts accountancy firm Craig , Gardener, and Co in Dame Street, Dublin. The international round table was concerned that the waters of their plan were muddying,

“changing the name from ‘British Empire’ to ‘Commonwealth of Nations’ giving the chief dependencies of India and Ireland , their complete independence (but gradually and by free gift rather than by under duress)” ⁴⁹⁸ had Collins out of sync with the round table, but with them as a brother of the IRB.

Part of the treaties problem was the swearing of allegiance to the crown, required in effect an allegiance to the crown of the Bank of England. Having up to 26 local land banks operating to serve the ordinary people with low interest rates providing them with the benefits of profits as co-operatives tend to do was a direct threat to the controllable, gradual and by free gift approach to the revolution.

Accordingly an Afrikaner who formerly fought with the Boar uprising in the Transvaal against the British was called in to resolve the problem of the civil war and the Collins problem.

General Jan Christian Smuts, who later became President of the new South Africa was sent to Cork in December 1921 to meet with Anti- Treaty forces, firstly to arrange a cease fire and he also the arranged the articles of agreement for Dominion status as a Irish Free State⁴⁹⁹,he arranged for the truce of June 1921, which eventually led to the treaty.

The fact that Collins signed the document was known to everyone to be the signature on a document anti-treaty forces were aware of before Collins returned to Ireland from London.

The “people” ratified it in a vote. the resultant civil war was therefore fought as an internal power struggle on issues all were complicit in, even those who found it difficult to swallow.

Collins was likened to Smuts⁵⁰⁰ in many ways When the boars were driven to the table after suffering scorched earth policies , executions and concentration camps, it was Smuts who urged the Boars to accept the peace deal. He argued that the Boars should have a form of independence but should fight in “England’s war”

This for Afrikaners was the sign of a traitor and they realised that in order to have independence they would have to bond together , against all outsiders , black and English, hence the Broderbund brotherhood was born. P. W

Botha was a future member as was W. A. de Clerk and its Calvinistic separatists theocracy became one of the world's most hated regimes. The doctrine of John Calvin also taught that there should be no "intermingling" of races, a term described as "sub-Christian" rather than "Old Testament" by Ivor Wilkins⁵⁰¹

Thus the Broederbond took on the mantle of the Orange Order, both having their origins in Holland. They regarded organisations like the Freemasons, the Round Table, and the Rotarians (in their opinion laced with Jews) as subversive to their heritage and culture, and as Aliens.⁵⁰² They hoped that a Nazi victory would free South Africa from the British yoke, whereupon they would exclude all Jews and the British.⁵⁰³

However, modelling their own society on the Aliens, they instantly became a contradiction, and took it further to the levels of the Klu Klux Klan, and beyond. Actively supporting Hitler and the Nazis, the Boer in Africa had the choice between an "Anglo-Saxon" civil service and government with Smuts and company and the Round Table or an "Anglo-Saxon" Afrikaner Nazi party.

Hitler incidentally had every Alien organisation like the Freemasons and Round Table groups, occult and Christian killed even after they helped him and the Nationalist Socialist party come to power. All that is except for one, the old Prussian Grand Lodge of Freemasons who were still refusing to admit Jewish Brethren.

All other Freemasonry lodges around the world since 1820 had abolished the rule to exclude Jews, except the Prussian lodges which were formed out of the Teutonic Knights, themselves the remnant of the Knights Templar. These actions by the Teuton/Nordic sons of Woden, pure white race, would set the world into war without end for decades.

Whichever side of the Jewish question you upheld in your nationality as either a "English" or "German" Anglo-Saxon (splitting the tribe) the chosen theology formed cross-channel allegiances, muddying the waters of the second world war in particular.

Spies and agents and double agents and triple agents and enigma machines, and code breakers, traitors and undercover heroes all providing a sub-plot to the war within a war. The rest of the world used and controlled, murdered as pawns on a chessboard.

Only where Alistair MacLean's Eagles dare to fly could the battle of Britain really be viewed. MacLean's subtle skill leaving the mystery, as to who the real traitors were, an academic point, especially as Colonel Turner soared to his death and the German airplane flees unchallenged into London from its

top secret mission. The story is a typical example of how OSS the forerunner of the C.I.A. have operated since the 1940s.

The rumours that a separate “South African” marksman was present the day in Cork the day Collins was shot persists in conversation. The day before he was killed he was in Cork, he was with the manager of the Hibernian Bank trying to locate missing funds⁵⁰⁴. Money from the customs and excise house, occupied by the I.R.A. in the civil war had apparently been lifted by them (approx £120,000.00, worth today £2 Million, a fine amount for any new government and successful alternative bank to re-acquire), the money it seems had been laundered through a London bank and back to Cork.

The London account was in the name of Erskine Childers⁵⁰⁵, who had been a signatory to the treaty with Collins and Griffiths.(also with Churchill, Lloyd George and Birkenhead). Childers was also good school friends with Lionel Curtis editor of the “Round Table”⁵⁰⁶ magazine. they had both been in South Africa, and Childers had become fanatically Anti- British .He had fought as a trooper in the Boer war and was a “pro –Irish Englishman”⁵⁰⁷, who sailed his yacht the “Asgard” (the mythical home of Odin (Woden) the All-father of the sons of Woden) into Howth harbour laden with rifles and cartridges, as a gift to the revolution.

£35,000 .00 was recovered by Collins that day. Smuts had been second choice behind Childers to lead the trip to cork in 1921, but Childers refused to go.⁵⁰⁸ It was also rumoured that Collins had I.R.B gold with him on route to the meeting, with the I.R.A and Eamonn Develera the next day,a meeting of course he would never reach.

Develera was also in close proximity, Childers was also with Develera awaiting General Collins.⁵⁰⁹ the following day.

Childers was eventually caught and shot and the shooting of Michael Collins has been portrayed in the version in the film “Michael Collins” . Collins was played by Liam Neeson, and the film potrayed Collins death as a kind of tragic accident.

The real cause of his death has more of a international aspect to it than the film portrays , instead we are left with the trite and the most convenient explanation. The reason for this is it starts to raise questions, concerning the economic reality that Ireland as a “free country” (or free state) has actually been yoked to for a thousand years and since 1922.The films version prevents awkward questions on the structure and administration of the “Dublin government” at the time of Irish independence, and those questions lead to further questions concerning the partition of Ireland, and the current “troubles” and government in Northern Ireland .The reality that Ireland both

North and South is a “commonwealth” country in status still, and the right to self determination still an aspiration unresolved.

The Collins murder is a familiar situation, leading to conspiracy theories, which has punctuated Irish fascination since, with many believing in a hidden hand, curiously this is a factor cited by Adam Smith in his “scientific” “Wealth of Nations as the hidden hand of economics”⁵¹⁰. This Scottish Economist said “the pursuit of self interest, without any central direction, could produce a coherent society, making sensible allocative decisions”⁵¹¹ encapsulating a free market economy, this greatly influenced Margaret Thatcher and indeed still drives Tony Blair.

Where were you when Collins was shot, indeed where were you when Kennedy was shot, well if you were Lee Harvey Oswald, your ghost could visit the “Kennedy Assassination Museum” in the book depository. The window he (Oswald) supposedly fired three shots through is now surrounded by a glass booth (to stop people removing souvenirs such as pieces of window frame) in which Oswald is not. This is the most accurate part of the Kennedy affair the authorities in Dallas have produced to date. If you were in New Zealand, in a different time zone, you could have read Oswald's life story and guilt before he was even charged in America⁵¹². The complete blackout of Washington on the day Kennedy was shot is a sign of a “black op” so states Colonel Prouty.(Prouty was played by Donald Sutherland in the film JFK)

Kennedy had also signed security memo 263, which effectively stopped the war in Vietnam, much to the horror of the military “wing” of the US Government. The film by Oliver Stone was also received with as much horror and Stone “was accused of almost everything bar mother molestation: (or) he has a war neurosis (or) he is homophobic? (or) he has fascist yearnings”¹.

These attacks have come from newspapers like the Washington Post and the Chicago Post or the Los Angeles Times. The film itself shows Jim Garrison (played by Kevin Costner) made to look ridiculous for bringing a prosecution linking Clay Shaw with far right elements in the C.I.A., to Kennedy’s death.

Jim Garrison who appeared in the film, remained a Judge in New Orleans and can also be seen in another film “The Big Easy”

In the film “JFK” Garrison sums up his prosecution by calling Kennedy’s assassination a “Coup de Taut”, to ensure the biggest business in America

(earning then in 1963) 80 million a year, he asks the Jury as the people, to recognise this as Fascism.

In his investigations Garrison was told that the organising principle of American society was for war. Kennedy signed Security action No 263 in September 1963, effectively ending the Vietnam war, he was assassinated in November 1963, and his replacement Lyndon Johnson reversed this in December 1963, by signing National Security memo No 273

On the day of the shooting Washington went into complete blackout⁵¹³ for hours beforehand, shutting down communications, after the shooting men who most likely committed the crime, were led away (as vagrants) by Police Officers, wearing non-standard issue uniforms, and pictures taken at the time show this to be the case⁵¹⁴

The employee of the Government involved in Black Ops at this time, has since come forward. His name is Colonel Fletcher Prouty, (retired) Chief of Special Operations, working for the joint Chiefs of Staff. Special operations was an euphemism for the “military support” of the clandestine operations of the CIA around the world. (no longer Mr X., as in the film) he has now confirmed the events of the Government in Kennedy’s military execution. (see film J.F.K. Oliver Stone “inside JFK”).

The tone and theme of this film are a sobering rejection of the technological approach to war, by any means from the most powerful nation on earth. Garrison was removed from his position of National Guard because of his actions, yet in the film he says “this was good news as it was never good for combat.....but this is (the investigation)”.

A direct cause of the current war in Northern Ireland is the famine of 1849 (one of many) says John Pilger in “Hidden Agendas”⁵¹⁵, which in turn is a product of “free” economics or “laissez faire” attitudes, which of course requires a “hidden hand” to prepare and guide the free economy in order “to let things happen naturally”.

If things fail to happen naturally, then the military “wing” which in Mr Pilgers book the chapter “Arming the World”,⁵¹⁶ helps us to understand Hegelian principles as they act against each other.

Capitalist America can stand against communist Russia, only after America gives Russia plutonium to create nuclear arms⁵¹⁷, fuelling “expansion” Once this has served its purpose new opposites are demonised and the arms race continues. One side are terrorists, the other freedom fighters. Usually the New Liberal capitalist democracies are the freedom seekers, or so the state capitalist press informs us.

This is why Plato warns us in his “Republic”⁵¹⁸ that Democracies can be dangerous and can become an instrument against the people.

On travelling Ireland you can view the television channel Radio Telefis Eirean and the foreign B.B.C., but British audiences, in Britain are blocked from viewing the Irish channels, is this a free democracy. The channels and the news transmitters are actually blocked by the British authorities for the past sixty years (although digital is changing this) this alone shows the level of brainwashing which over 50 million subjects in the U.K. have been subjected to.

This is a shame as many in England, Wales and Scotland may wish to know of the Nuclear contamination pumped from Sellafield onto their beaches, and into the Irish Sea, a kind of pollution war, black op.

The news on television shrieks terrorism as do the newspapers, their collective frenzied sounds are becoming almost subliminal in its high intensity of pitch yet the possibility of a terrorist attack in the lake district is swept aside mainly because it may only effect a few sheep or seals , who are probably becoming too numerous and well...in any overdue for a cull. The terrorist of the moment, like Saddam Hussein before him, is Osama Bin Laden, and like Saddam he is trained and armed by the CIA, who are currently waging “operation ultimate profit”

“Terrorism” in the worldwide (white) media has almost developed an inaudible high pitch scream, which scientists say vegetables and plants emit on being plucked or cut.

Interestingly a pensive, scientific and studious approach is devoted to this phenomenon by David Attenborough the naturalist.

In a recent nature documentary, he is seen slowly and calmly walking through rain forests on a faraway continent, in only slightly sweat stained khakis to examine, the little known habits and science of the parasite. He sits down opposite a huge tree, to describe the parasite which, with small beginnings and with unknown pre-historic origins, has bored its way into a single root of the skyscraper tree to feed on its nutrients, relying on the tree to do the work, to feed it.

As it feeds it grows and works its way up all of the root systems to “become” the tree. It develops a thick root itself as it extends up the tree and develops a bark of its own. For decades it grows unnoticed, until it finally begins to break through its host, it eventually duplicates the tree in shape and territory. The host then crumbles away and dies, whilst the parasite spreads another spore (or seed) which in turn will latch on to another tree, in a

“laissez-faire” hidden hand manner, viewing the healthy forest as an enemy, in which it is conducting a war.

The parasite is at war, and conducts its mission coldly, and quietly, the other trees unaware of its presence or intentions.

The parasite will eventually spread and choke all the forest until presumably it will turn on itself as without a host it will die, so presenting itself with a self-fulfilling paradox.

A large parasite – the Federal Reserve Bank, caused President Wilson to fail when he exclaimed in 1913, that he had betrayed his country, such is the system of credit finance, a parasite on a healthy world. Parasites however, live in fear of discovery and shriek when even sensing they may be disturbed. This parasite does not follow mainstream or established politics or philosophies, but adapts onto them all, it does not belong to the left or the right or centre, and it is undemocratic, and totally without conscience.

The section of the war which has been waged against the Irish/Scots peoples, is given any name except what is actually happening, or its real nature. Classification can either be religious, or political or tribal but never economic.

At age ten, I was fortunate enough to climb sixteen feet up a shaky ladder, to open the loft hatch in my grandfather’s house, and discover a rifle left there by James Connolly on his travels, he wrote:

“Whatsoever we do, let us keep on the safe side of the Church and not quarrel with them – which denounced the Untied Irishmen and ex-communicated the Fenians, Faith and Fatherland.... Oh yes. But don’t forget that when the Englishman was a Catholic and worshipped at the same altar as the Irishman, he plundered, robbed and murdered the Irishman as relentlessly as he did when, with sword in one hand and bible in the other he came snuffily chanting his psalms in the train of Oliver Cromwell. The question of religious faith has precious little bearing upon the question of freedom. Witness Catholic Spain devastating Catholic Cuba, the Catholic capitalists of Italy running down with cannon, the unarmed Catholic workmen, the Irish Catholic Landlord rack renting and evicting the Catholic tenant, the wealthy Catholic feasting inside the mansion, while the Catholic beggar dies of hunger on the doorstep.

And as a companion picture, witness the Protestant workmen of Belfast so often out on strike against their Protestant employers and their Protestant

ancestors of 100 years ago in active rebellion against the English Protestant Government”⁵¹⁹

Of course the Orange Order likes to keep the Protestant working class “in tune” with the establishment 1660 – 1798 – 1912 – 1922 and today this is one of its purposes as an orange “card”.

Ireland was neutral in the Second World War,(declared before 1940) as it was unsure as to what Hitler was, but they knew Churchill was evil. My Father remembers barricades of carts being placed in his village in case the Nazis invaded (they did parachute into Ireland many times), whilst other villages were welcoming them. Many Irishmen died fighting in WWI and WW II, yet in Ireland the general perception was that the English “Anglos” were fighting the German “Anglos” again and using France as the battlefield. They did not wish to get into a “family argument” after all Kaiser Wilhelm (Willy to Queen Victoria) was Queen Victoria’s grandson. In the Second World War Prince Edward abdicated for marrying a Catholic (a heinous crime) whilst plotting with many in the House of Lords to welcome Hitler and the Nazi/German aristocracy. Being a Catholic was not allowed (Wallace Simpson) but being a Nazi was acceptable.

My Grandfathers house in the West of Ireland, was a safe haven for English children (evacuees) from Hitlers bombs. They always returned years later as adults, and many claimed their time there was the best of their lives. It is fair to say that over the last 1000 years (or so!) only 99.5% of “Anglos” have wished for, participated in or even thought about war with Ireland, indeed they wished it not, but the distinctions between Irish and English men were exploited to the full. The “Irish” do not regard Englishmen as evil only those who control the war are culpable.

In World War I it was possible to produce armaments and/or materials for arms, in the South of England and export to Germany via Scandinavia.⁵²⁰ Armaments made in England at Vickers and other arms dealers were sold all over the world to all sides, often if war was going slowly it received a helping hidden hand and the economics of the war again went into expansion.⁵²¹ The exploits of Sir Basil Zarrahoff as a international arms dealer are incredible, selling to all sides, whilst being entertained by all sides, in diplomatic circles.

Many went also to Carson’s volunteers to protect Ulster, and also to the French, and also to the Irish in the South. Whilst Wall Street re-armed Germany via the I.G. Farben Company, ready for World War II. The

casualties of war are the millions who never realised the full extent of why they were fighting, just millions of ordinary people.

At age 17, I met another “shellshock” victim, a man who was then 88 years old. He recently moved back to his cottage, just up the road from my Grandmother. Although a millionaire, he still lived in the 3 roomed, stone-floored thatched cottage, used his old black Raleigh bike, dressed in a three piece black suit and looked after a small plot of vegetables on his hundreds of acres, on which he hunted (for food) with his two Wolfhounds.

He told me that he was nearly seven when the “Black and Tans” were released into Ireland by “Winston Churchill” to suppress the revolt in 1918. Many of these “soldiers” were released from Gaol if they promised to fight, many were murders and rapists.

Whilst walking one morning with his “sweetheart”, he was rounded up, as were many of the families in the area, for “questioning”. His sweetheart was pulled out from the middle into the open air, and a jam jar containing a rat was pushed up between her legs, and the glass end was heated by a match and a wick. The rat scratched and bit in-between the screams of the girl and the crowd did not have the information they sought, while they were forced to watch at gun point.

The “sweetheart” was still alive up until 1994, living alone, still a child, looked after by the village, whilst my friend lived only a mile from her, he visited her often, but they never married. He told me his life changed on that day, yet he would not join an army of any kind (also his advice to me), and his healing had taken over 80 years, always hoping to find a lost love, who was gone. She was unlucky, most were shot. Most in Ireland however do not heed any advice as far as abstaining from military activities are concerned and preferred revenge, with semtex and bullets the preferred reply.

Michael Collins said “Anything can come true if you believe hard enough” quoting

J. M. Barrie, whose illustrations of Captain Hook resemble very closely the features and apparel of William of Orange! (J M Barrie also saw the “Darlings”, or rather the children whom he adopted and modelled in his Peter Pan stories killed one way or another by the first World War and must have regretted his secret service activities for Mi5)⁵²².

During Collins stay in London he was fond of telling the security forces that followed him, to leave him alone as he went to Mass in a Roman Catholic church. Whilst he did not mind being accused of sub-version, he would not be held accountable for conversion. yet in his younger days he told astonished audiences that all Roman Catholic Priests should be exterminated.⁵²³

He was fully versed in the bible also, his favourite books and writings of the Apostle Paul

“ I know him fairly well, you see he had the divine saving grace of not having been always good”⁵²⁴ the reference to Paul referring to his days of spying, executions and espionage on behalf of the Roman authorities, and Jewish zealot revolutionaries of occupied Israel two thousand years ago. Passing from bad to good however involves a road to Damascus experience, which of course eventually signed Pauls own death warrant.

Today the war in Northern Ireland has been conducted on Apartheid, assassination, drugs and banking, ran by the state in the name of Our Lord Jesus Christ who supposedly runs the operation through his representatives in the state who uphold the tenants of the Christian faith as inviolate. This is the promise many take for granted when taking office, instead it is they who have become the terrorists, and “anti – Christ” in nature.

Unpublished papers from the late W. J. Brennan-Whitmore (Commandant) of 4 Ballymon Drive, Dublin 11 E.I.R.E. were passed to me. He was Michael Collins intelligence officer, and as well as taking part in the 1916 uprising, he was also imprisoned with Collins at Frongoch interment camp in Wales.

After the treaty was signed and partition voted upon Commandant Brennan –Whitmore, completely rejected them both. therefore both he and Collins were on opposing sides in the civil war .Having read this extract it is clear that the thinking of both men were the same, both I.R.A. and Free state, this is because both knew only a separate economic system would mean freedom, and that separate system should extend to the counties of Ulster. His pessimistic outlook, looks down on the advance Michael Collins made, and did not foresee the release of the Irish Stock Exchange in 1996 from London (through which it had to trade), but perhaps he foresaw the growing Irish National Debt (33 billion)⁵²⁵ managed by the National Debt Management Agency in Dublin, which advises the Department of Finance and Dial (treasury) on how to manage the debt i.e. its interest rates etc. The N.D.M.A (now called the N.T.M.A.or National Treasury Management Agency !) . is in turn “managed” by the Union Bank of Switzerland⁵²⁶.

To place Brennan – Whitmores views with more contemporary Irish economists, we can see that the money problem whether it was troubling General Collins, or anti-treaty and anti- partition Republicans, or whether its those who work under the “Celtic Tiger” in the new Millennium, the problem is the same.

“There is an understandable tendency for newly emerging countries to confuse NATIONAL AUTONOMY with NATIONAL SOVEREIGNTY⁵²⁷.

SOVEREIGNTY is the ability of a nation to act on its own rather than under the the coercion of other nations.

NATIONAL AUTONOMY on the other hand, describes the ability of a nation to attain its desired objectives, such as economic growth or full employment if necessary through UNILATERAL action. In the economic sphere the autonomy of small nations is heavily circumsised and the recognition of this truth represents a wise exercise of NATIONAL SOVEREIGNTY.

James Connolly’s prophecy that Irish independence might amount to a switching of flags and symbols was amply demonstrated in the first four decades of the Irish free state.”⁵²⁸

Since the same existed up until 1996 the same can be said of the following four decades, since the war (WW2), NOW OUR Autonomy is shared with Switzerland and the European Central bank. Only full sovereignty can provide total security. Lets hope and pray the Swiss are not yodelling gratuitous predestination, and take the Von Trapp side of the argument.

And when all is said and done, the last hundred for “Irish” Men and Woman, has fared better under a “Zionist led revolution” and Republic, than it did under the Union, and Anglo rule of a thousand years, in death statistics alone. Atrocities committed on both sides In between these two opposing philosophies is Christianity, which the master race claim is only for themselves alone.

The debt owed to the “Irish” (The Scots) by “England” can never be repaid, although ther has never been any effort to do so. The main reason could be that to begin to repay for upwards of two million deaths is impossible, but that reason is doubtful.

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Banks and National Prosperity

1969

An Toaiseach, Mr. Sean Lemas, at the re-opening of the Ulster Bank branch in College Green, Dublin, is reported as having said: "Ireland is fortunate in having a sound banking system which commands public confidence; this is an asset of very great value, and economic progress depends on it."

The entire context of the history of Irish banking policy, and economic progress, disproves this laudatory statement. It is true that banking in Ireland, from the viewpoint of the security of deposits therein, is a sound institution; and to that extent the public have a justifiable confidence in it.

With regard to the policies pursued by our so-called Irish banks, from 1783 to the present day, it is contrary to the fact to suggest that the policies of those banks are "an asset to Ireland: and economic progress depend on them."

It is perfectly true, however, to say that where banks are national institutions - in the proper sense of the term, national: and where their investment policies are directed towards the industrial end economic advancement of their

country, banks are of an immense and even vital importance to the well being of their community. The history of the Ulster Banks and the Ulster Bank Fund proves that conclusively. There is a wide difference between the domestic policies of the three Ulster Banks and the Ulster Fund, and the financial policies of the other banks in the twenty-six counties.

Banks are the depositories of the capital money of a nation. Without the internal investment of the capital money of a country there can be no industrial development or economic progress worth speaking of.

For the past 179 years Ireland has not possessed a national bank, or a national financial system. All banks in this country throughout that long period of time, have been British banks and their financial policies (with the exception of the three Ulster Banks) have been that of channeling Irish capital money to England for investment there.

These financial policies have been the main - I might even say, the sole, - cause of our national impoverishment, our lack of industrial and economic progress and our appalling drain of emigration. With regard to this latter scourge, it may be laid down as a cardinal principle that: where the capital money is invested there - and there only - will be found gainful employment. Since we have been exporting our capital money, mainly through the banking and foreign insurance companies stock exchange system, to England for investment there we must, willy-nilly, export our young men and women after it. As water finds its own level, naturally employment find its natural level in capital-investment. It has been estimated that over a period of some 30 years we have exiled some 600,000 of our virile, wealth producing youth. What a national tragedy! The economist, Mill, laid it down: "The severest indictment of any

administration was a declining population in a fertile land." Who can deny the truth of it?

It is true, of course, that since the establishment of the Free State our banks have been making a limited investment in Irish affairs. They lend money to our government', they buy portions of government loan stock, etc. But the fact remains that the great bulk of our capital money is still being channel to England.

Professor Gregory, the eminent authority on banking, states when a country attaches itself to Sterling, it subordinates its domestic policy to the view of those who control sterling." Those who "control Sterling" constitute the Court of the Bank of England. And this Court is no friend of the industrial and economic progress of the people of Ireland.

To take a concrete example. When the re-armament programme was planned in England, prior to the Second World War, it became necessary to dis-employ workers in the consumer goods industries and re-employ them in war industries. That change over was speedily effected by currency restrictions and technical currency manipulations. In order to ensure the minimum disturbance of consumer goods in England it was essential that a maximum influx into England of Irish emigrants be secured. That influx was easily effected because we are ruled by the British financial system.

In a Press interview in 1951 the President of the N.A.I.D.A Mr. R. E. Whelan stated: "The overriding fact in the economic structure of the Republic is that it is a Sterling Currency Area In so far as economic fact is concerned the currency is Sterling there is no such thing as an "Irish Pound".

It is misleading for the Central Bank Report to attempt by process of suggestion to convey to the public, including An Dail and the Government, the

idea that there is such a thing as an "Irish Pound." The Irish Treasury Note is, for economic purpose in exactly in the same category as a Scottish Bank Note or as the Bank of Ireland Note, the National Bank Note, etc., which exist all during the period of the Union."

" As the law stands today, and as economic facts, including the investment position and trade relationship, the Government of the Republic has no control whatsoever over the currency position in the Republic. It follows that the Irish Government has no power to effect the cost of living, inflation or deflation devaluation or revaluation.

"Much of the confusion in the minds of the ordinary citizen including politicians, arises from the mistaken idea that Parties or Governments in Dublin are responsible for movements in the cost-of living resulting from inflationary tendencies or from stagnant trade resulting from deflationary tendencies and credit restrictions. The powers of the Irish Government are, in fact, restricted so as to be able to affect only the incident o the impact of the currency position as between individual and classes in (the Republic of) Ireland".

Rothschild, the greatest banker of all time, said that if he had control of a nations finance he cared not who made its laws. Most of us know the wonderful period of prosperity which occur in this country during the short period of the independence of Grattan's Parliament. Well, that prosperity was due to the fact that Grattan's Parliament had an independent National Treasury and National Currency. Today, after forty years of political independence, we possess as a nation neither a National Treasury nor a National Currency.⁵²⁹
